Williamsport Country Club Dress Code

All players and spectators are expected to follow the club's dress code as follows:

- NO cargo shorts or pants
- Boys, shorts 2 inches above the knee, shirt tucked and hats facing forward
- Girls shirts can be untucked, bottoms must be 16.5 inches or pants
- NO BLUE JEANS or DENIM

All parents must follow the same rules if watching, even though they are not playing.

WARM-UP INFORMATION

There are 3 warm-up areas available; range, chipping green, and putting green

- Please arrive early to give yourself additional warm-up time
- Please do not spend more than 15-20 minutes at each are in order to give each golfer ample time to prepare for the event

CONDUCT OF PLAYERS

A two-stroke penalty shall be assessed for conduct unbecoming an interscholastic golfer. Such conduct shall include, but is not limited to, club throwing, defined as releasing club in anger or in a manner to cause harm to any person or to the golf course; use of abusive language; willful acts which damage property or equipment of the golf course; or other unbecoming conduct, as determined by the Tournament Director.

USE OF A CADDIE OR MOTORIZED CART PROHIBITED

The use of a caddie or motorized cart during Practice or competition rounds WILL NOT be permitted. Contestants will be permitted the use of a non-motorizes push cart, or to carry their clubs and will be required to walk the course during the competition round(s).

USE OF RANGE FINDERS DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

During Regular Season and Postseason golf Contests, players are authorized to use devices that measure or gauge distance only. The device must not be used for any purposes that are prohibited by Rule 14-3, including but not limited to:

- the gauging or measuring of slope
- the gauging or measuring of other conditions that might affect play (e.g. wind speed or directions)
- recommendations that might assist the player in making a stroke in his play (e.g. club selection, type of shot to be played, green reading or any other advice related matter); or
- calculating the effective distance between two points based on the elevation changes or other conditions affecting shot distance.

A multifunctional device, such as a smartphone or PDA, may be used as a distance measuring-device, but it must not be used to gauge or measure other conditions where doing so would be a breach of Rule 14-3.

USE OF DRONES

For the purposes of this policy, a drone is any unmanned aerial device ("UAV"). Drones are not permitted above the competition surface or spectator areas during interscholastic Contests, Interschool Practices or Scrimmages. Drones may not be used to scout opposing team Practices. Member schools may utilize drones for their own school team practice sessions based upon their local school policies. Persons and/or schools violating this Policy shall be subject to sanctions which may be imposed under Sections 5, 6, 7 and/or 9 of ARTICLE XIII, PENALTIES, of the PIAA By-Laws. Upon timely requests submitted to PIAA, the Executive Director is authorized to grant exceptions to this policy on a case-by-case basis for PIAA broadcast partners in conjunction with any host school/facility local policies.

GENERAL RULE FOR COACH AND SPECTATOR DECORUM

Coaches and spectators will be permitted to walk the course and may be permitted to ride a cart on the course no closer than ten (10) yards from the contestants during competition. Coaches and spectators who choose to walk or who are permitted to ride the course BEHIND the contestants, during competition, may do so under the following restrictions: 1. DO NOT offer comments or make suggestions to the competitors. NO COACHING! 2. DO NOT observe play closer than ten (10) yards from the group of competitors being observed. 3. DO NOT cross over or observe play from teeing areas, fairways, or putting greens. Play may be observed from cart paths or the "rough" only. 4. DO NOT move or talk when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke. 5. DO NOT attempt to decide questions of fact nor attempt to apply the Rules of Golf.

*** ONLY SPECTATORS THAT ARE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTRY CLUB, OR HAVE PERMISSION DUE TO MEDICAL REASON, WITH PRIOR APPROVAL, MAY BE PERMITTED TO USE A CART
